Currently, 47.7% of the 47,421 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 45.1%, renter occupied; and 7.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 45,958 housing units in the area - 49.5% owner occupied, 43.5% renter occupied, and 7.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.40%. Median home value in the area is \$268,021, compared to a median home value of \$190,791 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.48% annually to \$317,943.
